Create your own field guide and go on an adventure!



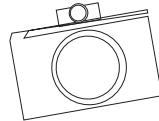
Gather:



a small notebook or a few pieces of paper stapled together

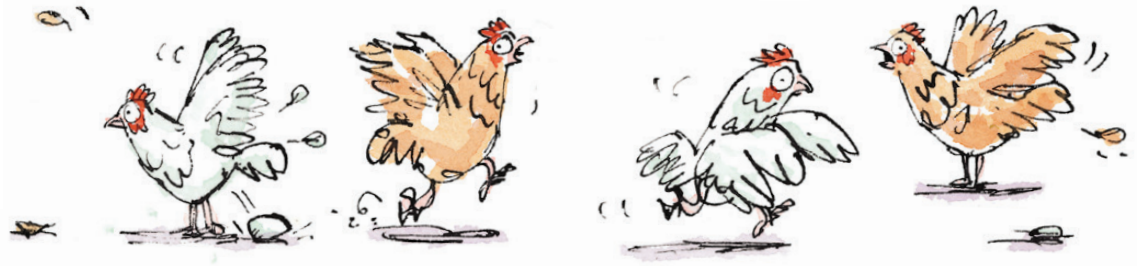


pen or pencil

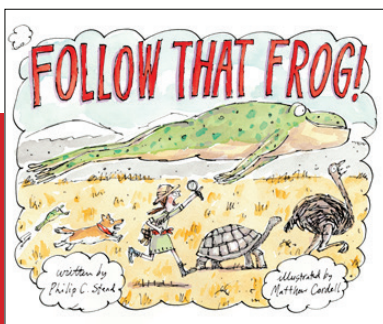

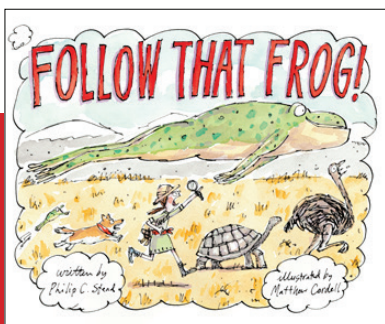
