





ABOUT THE AUTHOR



Make your own Blaster!

In Reptoids from Space, Carlton uses a blaster filled with Shrink Orbs to capture the Reptodackyl. You can make your own blaster with household items!

Make sure to have an adult help you.

Taken from Frugal Fun for Boys and Girls (https://frugalfun4boys.com/)

To make one you'll need:

- An empty plastic bottle (we used a 12-oz. bottle)
- Scissors
- String
- Rubber bands two per toy
- A large bead
- A nail for punching a hole in the lid of the bottle.

Instructions:

1. Cut off the bottom of the bottle. Then cut four notches around the edge. Slide the rubber bands through the notches so that they make an X as shown below:



2. Use a hammer and nail to poke a hole in the bottle lid (adult job). Tie a string to the connection of the two rubber bands. Run the string down through the hole in the lid, and then tie a bead to the bottom of the string.




3. When you pull back on the bead, the rubber bands gain potential energy. Release the bead, and the energy is transferred to the ball!


