



Can you identify which animals these colorful fur, scales, and feathers belong to? Look back through your book for hints!





Anteaters, Bats & Boas: **Rainforest Map Mania!**



This highest layer is made up of the tops of giant trees that grow up above the canopy where their leaves can capture a lot of sunlight. It is home to birds, bats, and butterflies.

In this layer, thick branches, vines, and leaves intertwine to form a kind of roof that shades everything below. Small plants, including orchids and ferns, grow on the trees. It's home to more birds, reptiles, mammals, and insects than any other layer.

Smaller trees and bushes grow in this hot, humid layer. Some plants here have large leaves to collect sunlight in this dark zone. Jaguars, birds, and amphibians live here.

Dead leaves and branches litter the ground of this bottom layer. Decomposers, including insects, worms, and fungi, help break down the litter into nutrients. Reptiles, amphibians, birds, and large and small mammals, including humans, also live here.




