MITZI'S RULES FOR DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP

Being safe is important both in the real world and the digital one. Just like you follow the rules to be a good citizen in your community, you need to follow the rules to be a good citizen in the digital world. That's called digital citizenship. Remember, the things you post on the internet STAY on the internet. Never post personal information that you don't want the whole world to see forever, and always tell a trusted adult if something doesn't feel right when you're using the internet.

HERE ARE SOME SMART RULES TO FOLLOW WHEN USING THE INTERNET:

- Always ask for your caregivers' permission before using electronic devices.
- 2. Keep personal information private. This includes your name, age, home address, phone number, email address, photograph, school, and anything else that you wouldn't tell a stranger.
- 3. Keep the personal information of others private. Don't share information about your classmates, friends, or family without their permission. This includes photographs!
- 4. Follow website rules, including age-usage requirements.

- 5. Never copy anything off the internet and present it as your own work. Remember to give credit, cite your sources, and never use copyrighted material without permission.
- 6. Never use any electronic device to cause harm to another person by harassing, intimidating, or just plain being rude to them. A pattern of this behavior is called cyberbullying. Bullying is never appropriate, whether you're in the classroom, on the playground, or at home on a device.
- 7. The "Grandma Rule"—Never access or post anything on the internet that you wouldn't want your grandma or even your teacher to see.






