## Make Your Own Chinese Kite!

## You will need:

- Red paper
- Black pen
- Red tissue paper
- 2 Straws
- Sticky tape
- String, thread, or yarn


## Instructions:



1. Cut a kite shape from red paper.
2. Decorate with black pen. We went for simple pictures of dragons and a border.
3. Cut strips of tissue paper. Tape 3 or 4 strips to the bottom of the kite.

4. Tape the two straws in a cross on the back of the kite as shown in the picture.
5. Cut two lengths of string about 18 inches long. Thread one through each straw and knot the ends together as shown.
6. Cut a length of string long enough to fly the kite if you wish. Tie one end to the knot that you have just tied.
