
Two siblings set off to live a life of adventure in the untamed wilds of their own backyard in this funny and beautifully illustrated picture book.




BE WILD!

ACLIVITA

Make a collage with the things you found on your nature hunt!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Clear contact paper
- Items from your nature hunt

DIRECTIONS: Ask a grown-up for help with scissors!

- Cut out two large pieces of contact paper and set one aside.
 Slowly peel the backing off of one of the sheets.
- Lay the contact paper sticky side up on a table (tape the sides down with masking tape so it doesn't curl up).
- 3. Gently press down the items from your nature hunt.
- 4. Peel off the backing from the second sheet of contact paper and carefully place it over your collage.
- 5. Hang the collage in a window!

You can camp out in your backyard or your living room and have an adventure!


