
For Ghost, it can be pretty hard to make new friends. Some people are frightened, others don't understand, and most don't seem to realize Ghost is even there.

YOU WILL NEED:


- Crayons, markers, color pencils-whatever you have!

- 4. Get dressed and get ready for an adventure with your new friend!









YOU WILL NEED:

- Construction paper (2-4 sheets, depending on how many pictures you have)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Your coloring utensils of choice

• A stapler

DIRECTIONS:

Ask a grown-up for help with scissors, the stapler, and glue!


1. Create your scrapbook. Take the construction paper and fold it in half, hamburger style. Do this to every sheet of construction paper you plan on using.


2. Have a grown-up staple the sheets of construction paper together along the folded lines.
