- A strong portfolio of original graphic design examples that demonstrates creative and skillful use of typography.
- Proficient in InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator, and Acrobat Professional. Familiar with Google applications.
- Solid verbal and written communication skills.
- Detailed knowledge of pre-press requirements for print and ebook.
- Strong time management and multitasking skills.

- Ability to work in a fast-paced, deadline-driven environment.
- Familiarity and appreciation for graphic novel design.
