Making Maracas!


Make your very own maracas!


Here's what you'll need:


- Two toilet paper rolls
- Duct tape
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Rice or dried beans
- Scissors
- A hot glue gun
- An adult to help you with the hot glue and scissors

Here's what you do:

- 1. Cover one end of a toilet paper roll with duct tape.
- 2. Fill the toilet paper roll halfway with the rice or beans.
- 3. Seal the other end of the roll with duct tape.
- 4. Slit open the second toilet paper roll all the way down one side to make a sleeve for the filled roll.
- 5. Use the glue gun to attach the sleeve to the filled roll.
- 6. Wait for the glue to dry, then paint your maraca anyway you wish.
- 7. Once the paint is completely dry, shake your maraca and make some music.







