Fun with leaf rubbing!

Leaf rubbing activity

Supplies:

- 1. Leaves from a tree outside
- 2. Paper (use the box below!)
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Crayons in your favorite leaf colors!

Directions:

- 1. Gather some leaves outside.
- 2. With an adult cut out the box below.
- 3. Place your leaves on a flat surface and cover with your piece of paper!
- 4. Use the long side of a crayon to gently rub the surface of the paper to reveal the shape of your leaves!



You can also make a bark rubbing by taping a piece of paper onto a tree's bark and rubbing the surface of the paper with your crayons!
