


# USE PALEOART TO *CREATE* YOUR OWN DROMAEOSAURUS!



## PAELOART *challenge.*

Did you know dinosaurs might have had feathers? In the mid-1990s, scientists in China discovered fossils with real feather impressions! That means scientists need new art for what dinosaurs really looked like!

Some scientists think that, like modern birds:

Male dinosaurs might have been bright and colorful. Female dinosaurs might have been camouflaged to hide while caring for eggs. But no one knows for sure — your Dromaeosaurus can be any color you imagine!

Here's what scientists think about Dromaeosaurus based on the bones they found. Use these clues to draw and color your own:

**SIZE:** About the size of a big dog — how big will you make yours?

**LEGS:** Stood on two strong legs with short arms — pose it however you like!

**FEATHERS:** Covered in fuzzy feathers — what colors would your dinosaur be?

**CLAWS:** A sharp sickle-shaped claw on each foot.

**EYES & TEETH:** Big eyes and pointy teeth — is it looking hungry or curious?

**CAMOUFLAGE:** Will your dinosaur blend in with the land or plants — or will it bright like a colorful male bird?
